The House provides comfort and shelter to families experiencing the pain of having a sick child in area hospitals by providing them with a temporary haven in a secure and comfortable environment among other families sharing a similar burden.

Dear Friends,

One of the joys of preparing an annual report is that it gives us the opportunity to look back and be thankful for all that has been accomplished. The past fiscal year was filled with wonderful opportunities and many challenges. Some of the highlights were:

- The House served a combined 4,430 families in New Hyde Park and Stony Brook Children's Hospital.
- Over 11,000 volunteers contributed their time and talents to helping the organization, including helping with tasks and responsibilities ranging from clerical, cooking and baking for our families, and helping with daily upkeep of the facility.
- RMH-LI embarked on the planning process to add a second Ronald McDonald Family Room at Stony Brook Children's Hospital to serve the needs of NICU families within the hospital.
- The House celebrated its 30th Anniversary of "keeping families close." Festivities included a 30th Anniversary Kick Off event along with special components that were added to each event throughout the year. The celebration culminated with our 30th Anniversary Gala at the House.
